Agreement on Academic Exchange

Tokyo Medical and Dental University (TMDU), Japan

Faculty of Medicine, Chiang Mai University, Thailand, and Faculty of Medicine, Tokyo Medical and Dental University (TMDU), Japan, conclude this agreement in recognition of mutual benefits arising from the establishment of effective academic relation. The purpose of this agreement is to promote scientific relation through academic cooperation between both parties.

- 1. Both parties agree to promote and develop this academic cooperation by the following means:
 - a. Exchange of staff member, undergraduate and graduate students
 - b. Staff development
 - c. Visiting professorship
 - d. Execution of joint research projects
 - e. Provision of lectures and seminars
 - f. Exchange of data, documents, research materials and academic information
 - g. Other mutually beneficial projects to be defined from time to time
- 2. Details of implementation are subject to discussion between two parties in any of the aforesaid means with specific cooperation plans. Details for staff exchange and academic information shall be included in an appendix.
- 3. This agreement can be revised or modified within the period of its validity by mutual consent. It can also be terminated within that period by either party with notification of not less than six months before its intention of termination.
- 4. This agreement shall be valid for a period of five years upon signature of both sides. The agreement can be extended beyond that period after discussion by representatives of both parties. The discussion can begin anytime before the final six months of the initial period of the agreement.
- 5. This Agreement is made in English in two copies, one for each party.

Memorandum on Student Exchange

Between

Faculty of Medicine, Chiang Mai University, Thailand

and

Faculty of Medicine,

Tokyo Medical and Dental University (TMDU), Japan

In accordance with clause 1 a), Exchange of students, of the Agreement on Academic Exchange concluded between Faculty of Medicine, Chiang Mai University, Thailand and Faculty of Medicine, Tokyo Medical and Dental University (TMDU), Japan the two collaborating universities agree on the details of student exchange as follows:

- 1. The sending university will decide which students should be sent to the partner university, with due consideration given to the receiving university.
- The status of visiting students at the receiving university will not be that of regular students. Furthermore, it is agreed and understood that the receiving university will not be compelled to award any degrees to visiting students.
- 3. All costs involved under this Memorandum (except items covered by clause 4, below) will be borne by each student or the sending university, although scholarships may be obtained independently from other institutions.
- 4. The receiving university will waive all charges for tuition and for any procedures involved in processing a visiting student's application.
- 5. The number of students exchanged and the period will be determined in advance each year by mutual consent.
- 6. When visiting students under this Memorandum are ready to return to the sending university, or soon thereafter, the receiving university shall provide the sending university with information on the academic performance of each of the sending university's students who visited the receiving university. The sending university may duly recognize the credits earned by its students at the receiving university in accordance with its own regulations.
- 7. Each university will, to the extent possible, assist students sent to it under this Memorandum in securing accommodations and achieving their study and research goals.
- 8. It is the responsibility of each student to ensure that they have valid health, accident and travel insurance throughout their stay as a student.
- 9. Both parties subscribe to the policy of equal opportunity and do not discriminate on the basis of race, sex, sexual orientation, age, ethnicity, national origin, religion or disability.

- 10. This Memorandum will be in effect during the academic year 2019-2020 and will be valid for 5 years, i.e. through the academic year 2023-2024. This Memorandum shall be renewed after being reviewed and renegotiated by both universities.
- 11. This Memorandum may be terminated by either university at any time by providing the other university with 6 months notice (in writing) of the intention to terminate.
- 12. Matters not covered by this Memorandum shall be discussed by the two universities in consideration of the Agreement on Academic Exchange between Faculty of Medicine, Chiang Mai University, Thailand and Faculty of Medicine, Tokyo Medical and Dental University (TMDU), Japan.
- 13. This Memorandum is made in English in two copies, one for each party.
