

Memorandum of Understanding for Academic Collaboration
Between
The Faculty of Medicine Chiang Mai University
And
The School of Medicine and Nursing Chengdu University

The School of Medicine and Nursing Chengdu University in P.R. China and the Faculty of Medicine Chiang Mai University in Chiang Mai, Thailand (hereinafter refer to as "Parties"), conclude this memorandum, recognizing the mutual benefits of collaborating academically. The purpose of this memorandum is to specify ways in which this academic collaboration can be conducted together.

Both parties agree to promote and develop this academic collaboration by:

- a) admitting staff and students to the other party's postgraduate programs,
- b) exploring the possibility of exchanging students and research personnel
- c) exploring the possibility of joint research projects
- d) exchanging information and academic publication
- e) engaging in other mutually beneficial projects.

Staff members of both parties will be encouraged to consult with each other and develop specific plans for collaboration in any of the ways mentioned above.

Recognizing that any form of academic collaboration requires funding, both parties will make a maximum effort to find sources to fund the activities above.

This memorandum will become effective on the day that representatives of both parties Sign it; it will valid for an initial period of five years. The memorandum may be extended beyond that period after discussion by representatives of both parties. The discussion can begin any time before the final three months of the initial period of the memorandum.

This Memorandum may be revised or modified within the period of its validity by mutual consent. It may also be terminated within this period by either party, as long as one party gives the other party not less than three months written notice of its intention to terminate the Memorandum.

Addendum

This memorandum was signed on May 9, 2013. It remains in force until May 8, 2018.
