

Memorandum of Understanding

This cooperation agreement is jointly developed by both parties.

Party A: **Yan'an Hospital of Kunming City, People's Republic of China**

Party B: **Faculty of Medicine, Chiang Mai University**

In order to build a good co-operational relationship and promote the development of both parties and to maintain a long-term cooperation based on the principle of equality and mutual benefit and after full consultation, both parties voluntarily reached the following agreement:

1. Both parties will provide conducive exchange programs for doctors, nurses and administrative staff.
2. Both parties will exchange information via medical papers, nursing theses, teaching papers, publications and academic information.
3. Both parties will conduct exchanges for hospital staff and scholars.
4. Both parties will conduct exchanges for doctors and nurses in specific departments so as to promote the development of the departments involved.
5. Both parties will share information from academic conferences and discussions on medicine, nursing, teaching and research.
6. The agreement is subjected to amendments and changes due to unpredictable factors.
7. The agreement is written in English. Each party will keep one copy and the agreement shall take effect from the date of signature.
8. Any amendment not approved by both parties in writing is invalid.
9. Details on the execution of the agreement will be drafted with the consultation of both parties.
