

# **REGULATIONS**

# **ELECTIVE PROGRAM /SHORT TRAINING PROGRAM**

- 1. The elective is an observation, no hands or academic credit given. The trainee will need to follow the rules, regulations and program schedule assigned by supervisor.
- 2. The trainee will receive a certificate of elective/short training program accomplishment at the end of the rotation.
- In case that trainee's performance is inappropriate and/or goes against the Faculty's regulations, the
  Faculty reserves the right to terminate the Elective/Short Training Program or to decline to give a
  certificate or any confirmation documents.
- 4. English is the language used for interactions in our elective/short training programs. Applicants who are not native speakers of English should be checked to ensure that their English language is at a proficiency level specified for the program. A good level of English (listening-reading-writing-speaking) is required.
- 5. It is recommended that the trainee arrange his/her own health evaluation, vaccination, and health insurance prior to coming to Thailand.
