



AGREEMENT OF COOPERATION
BETWEEN
CHIANG MAI UNIVERSITY
AND
I-SHOU UNIVERSITY



Chiang Mai University, Chiang Mai, Thailand, and I-Shou University, Kaohsiung, Taiwan, conclude this agreement in recognition of mutual benefits arising from the establishment of effective academic relations. The purpose of this agreement is to promote scientific relations through academic collaboration between both institutions.

1. Both institutions agree to promote and develop this academic collaboration by the following means:

- (a) Exchange of staff members, undergraduate and graduate students
- (b) Staff development
- (c) Visiting professors and scientific visits
- (d) Execution of joint research projects
- (e) Provision of lectures, seminars, and conferences
- (f) Exchange of data, documents, research materials and academic information
- (g) Other mutually beneficial projects which may be defined from time to time

2. Implementation of any particular exchange resulting from the above, shall be first initiated by consulting with each other, leading to the joint development of specific plans and details for each academic collaboration. Detailed agreements between individual faculties, colleges and/or academic units may be added as addenda to this Agreement.

3. This Agreement shall be effective from the date of signing for a period of five years and may be revised or modified within the period of its validity by mutual consent. The Agreement shall be reviewed during the fifth year to evaluate the progress and the quality of the mutual cooperation.
