


**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**  
**BETWEEN**  
**FACULTY OF MEDICINE, CHIANG MAI UNIVERSITY, THAILAND**  
**AND**  
**THE FIRST PEOPLE'S HOSPITAL OF HONGHE AUTONOMOUS PREFECTURE**

Faculty of Medicine, Chiang Mai University, Thailand, and the First People's Hospital of Honghe Autonomous Prefecture, China, conclude this agreement in recognition of mutual benefits arising from the establishment of effective academic relation. The purpose of this agreement is to promote scientific relation through academic collaboration between both institutions.

1. Both parties agree to promote and develop this academic collaboration by the following means:
  - a. Exchange of staff member, undergraduate and graduate students
  - b. Staff development
  - c. Visiting professorship
  - d. Execution of joint research projects
  - e. Provision of lectures and seminars
  - f. Exchange of data, documents, research materials and academic information
  - g. Other mutually beneficial projects to be defined from time to time
2. Details of implementation are subject to discussion between two parties in any of the aforesaid means with specific cooperation plans. Details for staff exchange and academic information shall be included in the appendix.
3. This agreement can be revised or modified within the period of its validity by mutual consent. It can also be terminated within that period by either party with notification of not less than six months before its intention of termination.
4. This agreement shall be valid for a period of five years upon signature of both sides. The agreement can be extended beyond that period after discussion by representatives of both parties. The discussion can begin anytime before the final six months of the initial period of the agreement.
