

AGREEMENT FOR ACADEMIC EXCHANGES AND COOPERATION
BETWEEN
CHIANG MAI UNIVERSITY, KINGDOM OF THAILAND
AND
GUNMA UNIVERSITY, JAPAN


Chiang Mai University, Kingdom of Thailand and Gunma University, Japan, recognizing that academic exchanges and cooperation between the two Universities would be beneficial to all concerned, agree upon this Agreement as follows.

1. The two Universities will encourage the following activities.
 - (1) Exchange of faculty members and researchers
 - (2) Exchange of undergraduate and graduate students
 - (3) Conducting joint research and academic meetings
 - (4) Exchange of information, publications and materials for academic purposes
 - (5) Other activities as may be mutually agreed by the two Universities
2. The aforementioned activities shall be realized by means of consultation and the exchange of relevant information between appropriate members of the two Universities.
3. This Agreement shall become effective from the date being signed by the official representatives of the two Universities and shall remain valid for a period of 5 years. This agreement may be renewed for a further period of 5 years by mutual agreement prior to the date of expiry.
4. This Agreement may be amended by the Universities upon mutual agreement.

MEMORANDUM ON STUDENT EXCHANGE BETWEEN
CHIANG MAI UNIVERSITY, KINGDOM OF THAILAND
AND
GUNMA UNIVERSITY, JAPAN


The academic exchange between Chiang Mai University, Kingdom of Thailand, and Gunma University, Japan, as it relates to the exchange of students, will be implemented as follows:

1. The purpose of this exchange program is to provide opportunities for the students of each University to gain international experience by completing part of their education in the foreign host University, thereby fostering goodwill and mutual understanding between Japan and Kingdom of Thailand.
2. The period of enrollment at the host institution for students participating in this exchange program will not in principle exceed one year.
3. The number of exchange students will be up to 4 students per year from each University. The goal is to maintain an approximate balance in the number of exchange students between the two Universities in the period of this Agreement.
4. Exchange students will continue as candidates for the degree at the home University and will not be candidates for the degree at the host University. The status of each exchange student will be a non-degree special auditing student or non-degree special research student.
5. Each exchange student shall be nominated according to the relevant procedure at the discretion of the home University. The host University will admit exchange students according to its established policies, procedures and availabilities. The host University will provide a certificate to the home University on the academic performance of each exchange student upon completion of their exchange. The home University may duly recognize the credits earned by the exchange students in accordance with its own regulations.
6. Exchange students shall be exempted from the application, registration and tuition fees at the host University.
7. The host University will assist the exchange students to the fullest extent possible when finding reasonable accommodation.
8. The host University shall not be responsible for students' personal expenses, such as the cost of travel, accommodation, meals and required health/medical insurance.
9. This exchange program shall commence from the date of signing of this Memorandum.
