



## Memorandum of Understanding for Student Exchange between Chiang Mai University and Kagawa University

According to the Academic Exchange Agreement between Chiang Mai University (Chiang Mai, Kingdom of Thailand) and Kagawa University (Takamatsu, Kagawa, Japan), (hereafter referred to as the two universities), the two universities have agreed to carry out the mutual exchange of undergraduate and graduate students (hereafter referred to as students) in accordance with the following detailed rules.

1. During the term of the agreement, each university may embark on student exchange activities with the partner university.
2. Acceptance of each student will depend on the capacity at the host faculty or institution.
3. The specialized study field for the exchange student must be in an academic area within the host faculty or institution.
4. The host faculty or institution shall provide the proper teaching staff to supervise the student.
5. Students participating in the exchange program should be those who are recommended by the home university on the basis of their academic performance, behavior and motivation.
6. Students participating in the exchange program should be screened in accordance with the principle of the host university.
7. The period of stay should last no more than one year.
8. Regarding the responsibility for tuition and other expenses, an agreement has been reached between the two universities as follow:
  - (1) The host university will not levy an admission fee, an examination fee, or tuition fee to the foreign exchange student.
  - (2) Travel expenses, room and board expenses, text book fees and personal injury insurance premiums, etc., are the responsibility of the student concerned.
9. Both universities will support the exchange students by recommending to them appropriate accommodation facilities in accordance with their requirements.
10. Although any exchange student shall have only non-degree status at the host university, both universities are obliged to mail a transcript for the student concerned to the home university at the end of the exchange term. The credits shall be approved by the home university.
11. Students participating in the exchange program must comply with the regulations of the host universities.
12. These detailed rules can be revised by mutual consent between the two universities.
13. These detailed rules are valid for 5 years from the signature date, and can be renewed every 5 years unless one side presents a written notice of intention to the other not to renew, 3 months before the date of expiry.

These detailed rules are effective as of the date of signing by both representatives of the two universities.
