

Details of Student Exchange Project

between

Faculty of Medicine, Chiang Mai University and Kobe Pharmaceutical University

1. Purpose

The following details implement an exchange of students, one subject of the Memorandum of Understanding between the Faculty of Medicine, Chiang Mai University and Kobe Pharmaceutical University.

2. Requirements for Exchange Students

- (1) Both institutions will exchange students, based on the principles of equality and reciprocity.
- (2) Graduate students who have enough ability to attend technical courses will qualify as exchange students.
- (3) Both institutions will recommend appropriate exchange students with good academic records.
- (4) Each host institution will decide on the acceptability of recommended exchange students by an impartial evaluation.
- (5) In principle, the number of exchange students admitted by each institution will not exceed one per year.
- (6) The status of exchange students will be 'non-degree special research student' at the Faculty of Medicine, Chiang Mai University, and 'non-degree special research student' at Kobe Pharmaceutical University.
- (7) The institution sending the student will not be required to pay any of the standard academic fees of the host institution such as examination fees, admission fees and tuition.
- (8) The host institution will not be required to pay travel expenses, medical bills, accident insurance, or cost of living, including housing expenses and other personal expenses of exchange students.
- (9) Both institutions will provide exchange students with relevant courses of study, and they will give academic credits based on the results of examinations. The home institution, following its regulations, will give the credits equivalent to the credit that exchange students gain at each host institution.
- (10) The period of study for exchange students at each host institution will not exceed one full year. However, students may be allowed to extend the period by mutual negotiation and consent.

3. These details, when necessary, will be revised by mutual negotiation and consent.

4. Two copies of these details, one written in Japanese and valid one in English will be kept by each institution, both the Japanese copy and English copy being equally authentic.
