



Memorandum of Understanding

Article 1 Preamble

The Medical University of Graz, Austria, and the Faculty of Medicine, Chiang Mai University, Thailand (hereinafter "the parties"), hereby agree to embark on cooperation in the areas of research, faculty and student exchanges, and other related activities deemed by the parties to be in their mutual interests.

This Memorandum of Understanding sets out the understanding between the parties and their intentions regarding this cooperation. It is not intended to create a binding or legal obligation on either party.

Article 2 Objectives

The objective of this cooperation is the development of scientific programs within the areas of mutual interest, including the following:

- 1. Scientific cooperation in selected research projects
- 2. Faculty exchanges
- 3. Promotion of student exchanges
- 4. Promotion of researcher exchanges
- 5. Joint research activities
- 6. Cooperation on joint conferences, seminars, symposia, and exhibitions.

Details of any such activities will be jointly agreed upon by the parties in separate agreements.

The parties shall decide through consultation the specific areas and details of co-operation within the framework of this Memorandum of Understanding, and shall consult with each other from time to time at the request of either party, for the purpose of reviewing the operation of this Memorandum of Understanding.

The financial arrangements involved in the implementation of this Memorandum of Understanding shall be settled through consultation between the parties in respect of each program of co-operation.

Article 3 Final Provisions

This Memorandum of Understanding is not-binding. Either party may withdraw from this collaboration at any time with written notice given, for whatever reason. It is to be clearly understood that there will not be any legal liability for either party if this collaboration is terminated.

Any collaboration under this Memorandum of Understanding becomes binding only after a separate agreement is signed by both parties.

This Memorandum of Understanding may be amended and supplemented by a written agreement between the parties. Amendments and/ or supplements will be appended as an annex.
